## Decision

Following the financial awarding system for the 2023/2024 season approved, in accordance with Section 9 of the Rules and Guidelines concerning the national cadre, by ULP committee on 21 May 2024, and the rapport of the national coach, Soňa Kroulíková, of the awarding points of Cadre skaters,

I decided to award

**Caroline Toft**, in recognition of the best score of the 2023-2024 season in the Advanced Novice category (Christine Colson Cup, Liège, 2023 - 87.9 points) and for her exceptional performance, a prize of €200. In addition, for achieving a Double Axel during the competitions, a bonus of €100.

**Julie Straus**, in recognition of achieving the best score of the 2023-2024 season in the Basic Novice category (Challenge Cup, Tilburg, 2024 – 32.78 points) and for her outstanding performance, a bonus of €100. In addition, for successfully performing a StSq level 2 with no negative GOE – in 2 different competitions during the season, a bonus of €100 (Coupe Christine Colson, Liège, 2023/Coupe du Printemps, Luxembourg, 2024).

**Alison Morgan**, in recognition of achieving the best score of the 2023-2024 season in the Basic Novice category (Coupe du Printemps, 2024 – 36.88 points) and for your outstanding performance, a prize of €200.

A financial award at the end of each season may be given to the cadre skaters with the best results of the season. Consideration is also given to the skater's behaviour, attendance at training sessions and respect for the rules.

The elements must be performed in a competition. Only international A and ISU recognized competitions are taken into consideration for the awarding. The minimum number of judges must be 3 for the competition to be considered for this award.
